
Dear Manager, Data Analytics and Insights - Super Strategic Insights

On this day, the 20th of November 2019, the QSuper Board ABN 32 125 059 006, the RSE licensee of QSuper ABN 60 905 115 063 has elected under Section 68AAF (dangerous occupation exception) of the *Superannuation Industry (Supervision) Act 1993 (SIS Act)* for members in the following products in the following occupations to be subject to the dangerous occupation exception:

1. Products subject to the RSE licensee's section 68AAF election:
  - a) QSuper Accumulation Account, including any Choice Product and/or MySuper product within a QSuper Accumulation Account;
2. Occupations subject to the RSE licensee's section 68AAF election:
  - a) Emergency Service Workers (as defined by the *Work Health and Safety Act 2011*) who:
    - a. On the commencement of this election are, or after commencement of this election become, a member of any of the following Emergency Services:
      - i. the Queensland Police Service;
      - ii. the Queensland Ambulance Service; or
      - iii. the Queensland Fire and Emergency Services, and
    - b. are under 25 years of age and/or have not had an account balance of at least \$6,000 from 1 November 2019 with QSuper that relates to the above Product.

The RSE licensee will also keep a record of the information it has relied upon to make this election under section 68AAF of the SIS Act.
